AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Rationale

It is recognized by the Board of Directors that the local school can play an important role in providing before and after school care services to parents who are unable to drop off or pick up their child at a specified time.

Policy

Schools offering programs providing care for students of Island Catholic Schools outside of regular hours of school operation must be licensed by the appropriate local authority.

Regulation

1. Schools wishing to provide after school care are required to receive approval from the Local School Council, and Superintendent of Schools.
2. Prior to approval, the Local School must satisfy all the conditions set out by the appropriate local authorities.
3. A copy of the license permitting an after school care program must be forwarded to the Superintendent of Schools prior to the commencement of the program.
4. The Local School Council will establish fees and procedures for the safe operation of the after school program.
